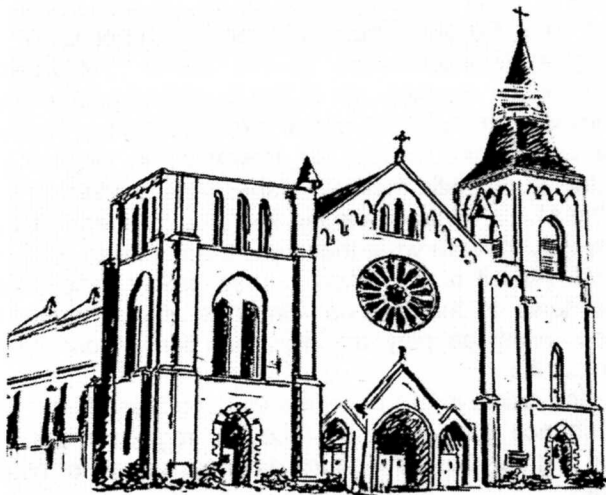

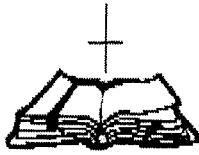
If you are moving away, we ask you to please contact the parish office so we can update our records.
