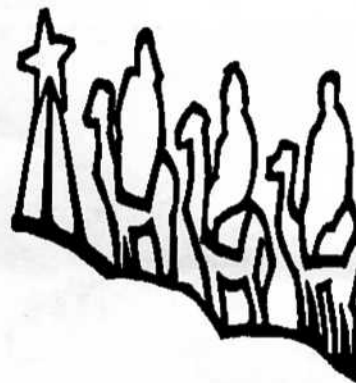

**Feast of the Three Kings**

Today we take home a box containing chalk and incense, in memory of the gifts of the Magi. At home we inscribe the date and "K+M+B" with the blessed chalk above every door in the house to provide protection against illness and misfortune for those within. It would look like "20 K+M+B 12." The letters, with a cross after each one, stand for names of the Three Kings—Kaspar, Melchior and Balthasar. They remain above the doors all year until they are inadvertently dusted off or replaced by new markings the next year.
