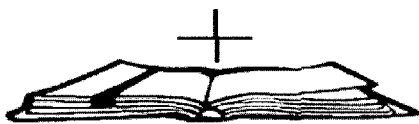

Holy Rosary Society: Please note, the next meeting will be on Sunday, July 14, 2013 after the 10:30 Mass. New members are welcome.

Neighborhood News: On June 18 a delegation of four parishioners (Ed Bosiaci/Parish Council; Diane Czajka/Parish Council; Norb Orłowski/St. John's Funeral Home and Judy Felski/Choir representing SJK attended a meeting held at Precint C, Fillmore and E. Ferry. Police Chief Aaron Young and other representatives of the Buffalo Police Dept. were present to explain the programs in place to assist neighborhoods in the fight on drugs, prostitution, unkempt properties, etc. The clear message that came through was that neighborhood issues need to be reported! This can be done by calling 911 for emergencies; 311 for issues concerning anything from drugs to unkept property; or by calling the CPO cell number 361-5036. A person does not need to be afraid to report a concern because the information is kept confidential. It is essential to make a report to keep a paper trail, especially in the case of renters not keeping up their property. The BPD is quite willing to address concerns but they are not mind readers...YOU need to make that call! Ideally it would be desirable to form a Block Club to represent our area and interact with Precint C on a regular basis...anyone interested in this? Representation of St. John Kanty at this meeting served to establish the concern we have for our area on the Eastside.
