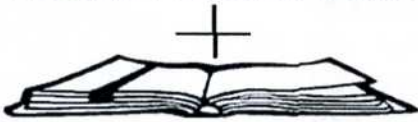

**ST. JOHN KANTY GARDEN MAUSOLEUM TO BE BUILT AT ST. ADALBERT'S CEMETERY-** Catholic Cemeteries of Buffalo has entered into an agreement with St. John Kanty Parish to manage St. Adalbert's two cemeteries. St. Adalbert Parish and St. John Kanty merged during the Journey in Faith and Grace, and the parish cemeteries are now the responsibility of St. John Kanty.

The two cemeteries, one located on Dale Road in Cheektowaga, the other on Broadway in Lancaster, will continue to operate. In response to increasing demand, St. John Kanty Garden Mausoleum will be built this Fall, adding 368 crypt spaces and 376 niches for the placement of cremated remains.
