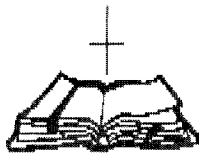

The two cemeteries, one located on Dale Road in the Town of Cheektowaga and the other on Broadway in the Town of Lancaster, continue to operate and serve families as they have done so faithfully for many years.

In response to increasing demand, St. John Kanty Garden Mausoleum is under construction, adding 368 crypt spaces and 376 niches for the placement of cremated remains. The mausoleum will be dedicated at a special Mass on Saturday, June 28, 2014 at 10:00 am. In addition, a much needed renovation of the office space was recently completed.
