A Message from Deacon Rick

This week we are celebrating the kingship of Jesus Christ. Jesus tells Pilate that he is a King – but His kingdom is not of this world. He tells Pilate, "Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice". If we were to read beyond the gospel reading, we would see that Pilate then asks, "What is truth?" That is the question for our time as well. There are those in our world that believe that truth is what we decide to make it. Unfortunately, that is just wishful thinking, for we will all one day be judged by the truth of Christ. We will be judged by how well we have loved God with our whole heart and mind – and our neighbor as ourselves. We are approaching the time of preparation.

This coming Advent we will be sharing evening services with St. Andrew's in Sloan, where there will be 'An Advent Evening of Reflection', on Wednesday, December 2nd at 6:30 PM.
