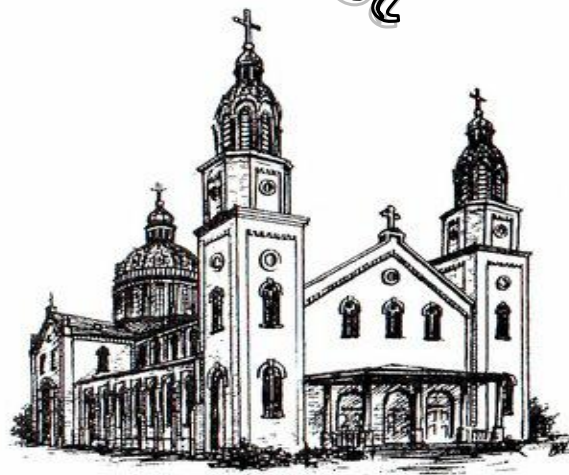
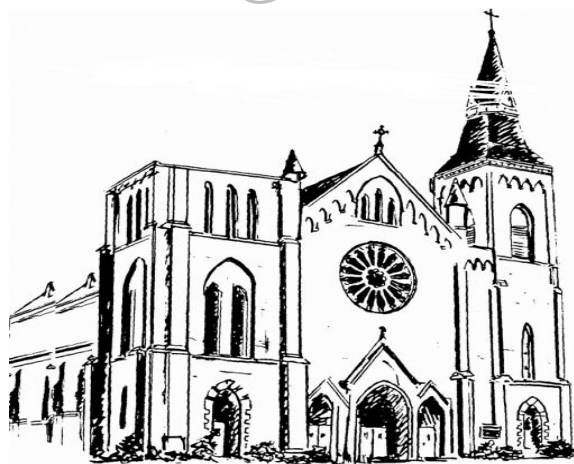

A Message from Deacon Rick

This week we are celebrating the kingship of Jesus Christ. Jesus tells Pilate that he is a King – but His kingdom is not of this world. He tells Pilate, "Everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice". If we were to read beyond the gospel reading, we would see that Pilate then asks, "What is truth?" That is the question for our time as well. There are those in our world that believe that truth is what we decide to make it. Unfortunately, that is just wishful thinking, for we will all one day be judged by the truth of Christ. We will be judged by how well we have loved God with our whole heart and mind – and our neighbor as ourselves. We are approaching the time of preparation.

This coming Advent we will be sharing evening services with St. Andrew's in Sloan, where there will be 'An Advent Evening of Reflection', on Wednesday, December 2nd at 6:30 PM. Then on December 21st, there will be an Advent penance service with examination of conscience followed by the opportunity for individual confession at that time. It would be a perfect birthday present for Jesus.

We have a very unique relationship with St. Andrew's. In 1915, Fr. Andrew Garstka, the pastor of St. John Kanty, asked Bishop Colton if a parish could be established in Sloan so that Kanty parishioners did not have to walk so far. Bishop Colton said yes and Fr. Garstka and the faithful parishioners of St. John Kanty founded St. Andrew Church. We have a special kinship with them.

You should also mark your calendar for our 10 AM Thanksgiving Mass which will be celebrated by Msgr. Bob as well. It will be a great way to start the Thanksgiving celebration. We are blessed to have this gifted former pastor here assisting us.

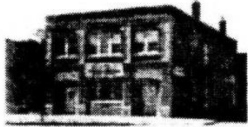
