A Message from Deacon Rick

As we arrive at this Forth week of Lent, it marks the midpoint in our Lenten preparation for Easter. This Sunday is set aside for us to recall God's graciousness and to rejoice because of it. In many ways we have been dead, but through God's grace we have come to life again; we have been lost, but have now been found. We have every reason to rejoice.

We are reminded in our Gospel of the tender story of the "Prodigal Son". There is the joy of a young son's "coming home" and rediscovering a father's forgiving and gratuitous love. It is also the story of a loving and forgiving father who celebrates the return of his prodigal son by throwing a big party in his honor, a banquet of reconciliation of the son with his father, his family, his community and with his God.

It is also the Parable of the Forgiving Father, the story of divine love and mercy for us sinners. It is almost beyond The common theme of joy resulting from reconciliation with God and other human beings is announced to all of us present in this church - an assembly of sinful people, ready to receive God's forgiveness, and His Personal Presence as a forgiving God in the Holy Eucharist.

I have prepared an examination of conscience reference called "Preparing for the Sacrament of Mercy and Peace" for your use when preparing to go to confession. It is available at the main and side entrances. Reflect on each of the questions to make a good confession. Your Father is preparing a banquet for you as well.

I also want to once again remind you that confessions will be available every Wednesday from 5 - 7 PM at St. Andrews in Sloan. We have confessions here before each Mass until Holy Week. Take advantage of these options as there will be no confession's before Mass during Holy Week at St. John Kanty.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE: All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain totally from meat on the following days: Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

FASTING: All Catholics between their 18th and 59th birthdays are also bound to observe the Law of Fast on the following days: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions in the course of the day.

EASTER DUTY: After they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter season, unless for a good reason it is fulfilled at another time during the year. This obligation may be fulfilled between February 14 (First Sunday in Lent) and May 22 (Trinity Sunday).
