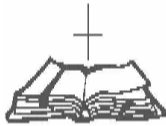

A Message from Deacon Rick

"Ephphatha – that is, be opened" – And immediately the man's ears were opened and his speech became clear." Mark 7:34

Jesus had the ability to read what was in people's hearts. When we read of the many healings that Jesus did, we note that before physical healings, there always was a healing of the heart that came first – what is inside the person. He often spoke of how that person had great faith. The physical healing was merely an outward sign of an interior healing. So often we stop at the outward sign, not recognizing the interior transformation that has taken place.

What happened when he opened the ears and mouth of this man who could not hear nor speak clearly, was that he could also more clearly understand what God was speaking to his heart. This is the more important healing because it affects our eternity, whereas, the physical healing terminates with death.

In our relationships with family, friends and acquaintances, it is also a part of our human experience to need healing with them as well. We all have a formidable weapon in our tongue, which may be fueled by a hurt or an attitude deep inside. We have to weigh in our mind, if the negative where we are coming from is worth our eternity? It never is. We never have to drink the poison that others may give to us. But, instead show the love of Christ, being like "pouring hot coals on their head" (Rom 12:20). It can affect a change in them.

Let us choose to be open to God's internal healing of our problem relationships. Being dysfunctional in today's world is the new normal – but it doesn't have to be. Choose wisely – a lot depends on it. Our relationships determine our eternity.

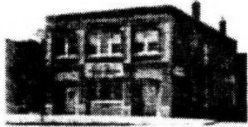
